ANIMATING WORSHIP:

An Interactive On-line Ministry Seminar for Church Musicians

Church musicians are unique in both the religious and secular realms. They are primarily servants, people with musical skills who use them to assist others in their worship of God. Unlike many performing musicians, the end of their performing is not the performance itself—excellent as it needs to be—but rather creating a holy process by which believers can "glimpse heaven".

Animating Worship is a continuing education series both practical and theoretical. It is designed for church musicians and those interested who are inclined to ask "why," "considering persons" who as they work in worshipping congregations are unsatisfied with mere artistry.

This set of courses is intended to help fill gaps among music, theology, and theory and practice of ministry; it is a means of providing synergistic university-level study in the home setting; it offers a rare opportunity for church musicians, clergy and persons-in-the-pew to explore together this unique vocation with sympathetic, supportive others.
